This can be Personalised for your loved one and arranged by myself.



Introduction

You may want to have your wedding ceremony

The chosen venue does not have to be licensed for marriages.

Wedding/Civil Ceremony

You will need to have a short legal ceremony first at your Local Registry Office.

The Legal Wedding or Civil Partnership



This legal part can be done early the same day, or even a day previous with just the two of you and two witnesses in informal dress if you want!

The rest of the service can continue at the venue of your choice where you will

say the vows you have chosen to say to each other. You can include or exclude anything you want including religious pieces, verses or poems and singing by family members or friends.

Rings can be exchanged and so on. These are all purely ceremonial and can therefore be performed at ANY LOCATION.

This is where myself as a celebrant becomes involved.



Renewal of Vows

These ceremonies are also ideal for couples who get married abroad and want to share their special day with family and friends when they return.



Renewal of Vows

It is now popular to renew your vows. This is a ceremony for couples who are already married but want to re-affirm their vows to each other for whatever reason. It could be a Special Anniversary, or after a particularly difficult time. Again these ceremonies can be however and wherever you want.

A copy of the marriage certificate will need to be shown before a Renewal of Vows or Wedding Celebration Ceremony can take place.
